

Sylvia"s Knitted Hood

Materials: 2 oz. knitting worsted
size 8 for large
size 5 for small
14" straight needles

Neck band: Cast on 68 sts loosely; K1, P1 rib for 3 ". On next row work **first 12** sts in ribbing and slip thses onto a holder. * Knit 2 **sts**, increase 1 st in next st. repeat from * 13 times more 56 sts on needle. Knit 2 slip last 12 sts onto holder (58 sts on needle)

Hood: Work even in stockinette st until work measures 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from beginning ending with a purl row.

Shape Hood:

row 1: Knit 37 slip 1, K1, pssso turn
row 2: slip 1, purl 16 purl 2 tog, turn
row 3: slip 1, K16 slip 1, K 1, pssso turn

repeat rows 2 and 3 until all sts have been worked 18 sts on needle. Slip these 18 sts onto a holder. Break off yarn.

Finishing border: With right side facing , pick up 12 sts from holder to first needle, attach yarn and pick up and knit 22 sts along right edge work k1, p1, ribbing across 18 sts of top, pick up and knit 22 sts along left side front edge. Put last 12 sts on 2nd needle and k1,p1 cross.
Work in K1, p1 ribbing until border measures 1". Bind off in ribbing. Sew center front seam

Note: Use smaller needle for small head- hood should measure 8" including 3" of ribbing.
