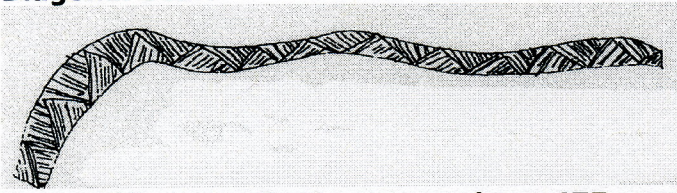


## Diagonal Scarf



**Yarn: 100 grams Sock yarn or about 475 yards**

**Needles: US3**

**Size: about 5" wide and 54" long**

**No gauge... it's a scarf!**

The Pattern:

Cast on 1 st

Row1: Inc into the stitch (2sts)

Row2: Inc into 1<sup>st</sup> st, knit to end (3sts). Repeat row 2 until one side edge of triangle measures 5", then begin short row section.

Short Row Section:

Row1: Inc, K2tog, turn

Row2 and all even- numbered rows: Knit

Row3: Inc, K1, K2tog, turn

Row5: Inc, K2, K2tog, turn

Row7: Inc, K3, K2tog, turn

Continue in this manner, increasing by one stitch in every odd-numbered row between the increases and the decreases (K2tog). Counting will soon be unnecessary as the decreasing is performed on the two stitches on either side of the gap that forms from the turn of the previous row.

Work until the last two stitches of the row have been decreased. **Do not do a knit row back, instead, turn and start over at row 1 of the short row section.**

Continue working short-row sections until 7-8 yards of yarn remain.

Finish the corner: (Note the number of stitches on needle before beginning this final short row section.) Work short rows as established until half of the stitches have been worked (round up if necessary). Then, at the beginning of each odd numbered row, decrease (instead of increasing). Work until 2 sts remain. K2tog and fasten off.

**Inc= knit into front & back of stitch**

**K2tog= decrease by knitting 2 stitches together.**
